

Directions for Downloading / Uploading Files to and from the **Aerospace Modeler Magazine FTP Site**

FTP (*File Transfer Protocol*) allows you to move large files (*usually images for ads and articles*) over the internet without going through e-mail servers on either end, which may restrict maximum file size.

1. If you don't already have a favorite FTP utility, you can download and save the **FREE** version¹ of **FTP Commander 8.0** (*for PC / Windows-based systems only*) using this link:

If you did this right, you should find a new **commanderftp** icon on your desktop. Click on the icon and then click on "Run" to get started. Agree with the Terms & Conditions, then click "Start" and "OK" as you're prompted.

2. Create new server:

On the FTP - Servers side (*right half of screen*), click the "New Server" icon. An "FTP Server Properties" dialog box will open.

Under "Server" and "User," set up the new server by **typing in the information in red**. Everything is case-sensitive!

Name: **AMM FTP** (*blank space " " instead of underscore "_"*)
FTP Server: **ftp.aerospacemodeler.com**
FTP Port: **21**

User ID: **amm_inbox** (*note underscore "_" instead of blank space " "*)
Password: **e-mail the Managing Editor at AMM to get the current password**

The boxes labeled "Save Password" and "Mask Password" should be checked. No other boxes should be checked.

Under "FTP Server Response Type," **"Default" should show on the menu box.**

Click the "Save" icon (*upper right corner of the FTP Server Properties dialog box*) to finish and return to the main screen.

3. Moving files:

To access the AMM FTP server you just created, simply double click on it. Alternatively, you can select it and then click the "Connect" icon (*upper left corner of your screen*).

To copy files or folders to and from the FTP server, open whatever directory you need from your computer on the left side of the screen and the AMM FTP server on the right side of the screen. Select the files/folders you wish to transfer and click the appropriate directional arrow in the middle to move the files/folders.

If you're unable to connect to the AMM FTP server, your anti-virus software may be interfering. Temporarily disable your anti-virus software and try again. If you have any questions or problems uploading your files, please e-mail us at editor@aerospacemodeler.com.
